STRUCTURED PROGRAM LAUNCH BUILT TO SCALE


- Launch a national program to create Veteran—focused hi-tech food production operations

 - 3-5 Veteran employees in Year 1 with one PODS 48'W x 48'L x 11'H
 - 20 30 Veteran employees in Year 2 with 5-acre greenhouse
 - 150 Veteran employees by Years 4/5 with full master plan
- 100% equipment financing and OpEx loan guarantees for \$0 capital launch
- Start with specialty crops and expand out and up with greenhouses
- Create permanent career paths and business ownership for Veterans


- Local ACTS Freedom Farms LLC controls PODS growing operations with optimum support from ACTS Freedom Farms Corporate, strategic partners and suppliers




3-5 Year Phased Build Out






20-25 Permanent Jobs Per 5-Acres

5-ACRE GREENHOUSE


LARGE SCALE VETERAN JOBS ENGINE






